**ORDER**

As per the Government Order read above, an amount of Rs.1,82,41,000/- has been allotted for the cost of permanent electricity connection to the newly built TATA Hospital for Covid 19 containment. The Deputy Chief Engineer, Kasaragod Electrical Section has submitted a revised estimate for the above work total amounting Rs.2,04,54,847/- and explained that the amount is increased due to ensuring extra safety measures by putting under ground cable and change in location of power room and has requested to sanction an additional amount of Rs.22,13,847/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakh Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Seven only). Hence District Collector, Kasaragod has requested to issue administrative sanction for utilising an additional amount of Rs.22,13,847/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakh Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Seven only) for the completion of the electrical work from the balance fund available in the SDRF, which was allotted for setting up of CFLTCs.

State Executive Committee meeting of Kerala State Disaster Management Authority held on 18/11/2020 examined the matter and approved the revised estimate for the work of permanent electricity connection to the newly built TATA Hospital utilising the balance fund available in District, which was allotted for setting up of CFLTCs for the above purpose.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the revised estimate for permanent electricity connection in the newly constructed Covid Hospital by TATA projects Ltd. for a total amount of Rs.2,04,54,847/- (Rupees Two crore four lakh fifty four thousand eight hundred and forty seven only). Administrative sanction is also issued for utilising an additional amount of Rs.22,13,847/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakh Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Seven only) for the above purpose from the balance fund available in District, which was allotted for setting up of CFLTCs.


