ORDER

Government as per orders read above has permitted short visit to the State for a period of 7 days without mandatory quarantine for certain purposes, which *interalia* includes the travel of bride/bridegroom and relatives for marriage ceremony. Now, requests have come up before the Government to allow the travel of wedding party to other States for marriage ceremony without observing mandatory quarantine period.

[2] Government, after examining the matter in detail, are pleased to permit the travel of bride/bridegroom and accompanying friends/relatives to other States on following conditions:

- All the members of the delegation should obtain prior permission from the counterpart State.
- The party shall obtain emergency transit pass from the district concerned showing the entry pass from counterpart State. District Collector concerned shall permit the journey of only those who have produced entry pass from counterpart State for this purpose.
- The wedding party shall keep all the social distancing norms while attending the function and shall not visit any other place than the venue for marriage.
- Any person, including bride/bride groom, who resided in counterpart State and comes back along with the party shall undergo mandatory home quarantine for 14 days.
- If any of the member stays overnight in the counterpart state, he shall undergo home quarantine.
- Marriage ceremony in containment zones of counterpart State is not permissible.

[3] The District Collectors, District Police Chiefs and other Heads of Departments shall take necessary action accordingly.
