ORDER

After analysing the present COVID-19 scenario in the State, the undersigned in his capacity as Chairperson of the State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred under Sec.20(3) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby authorises the District Collectors to impose ward-wise special stringent intensified restrictions in Panchayath areas/ Urban areas, in all such wards where the WIPR (Weekly Infection Population Ratio) is greater than seven (7).

The District Collector & Chairperson of DDMA's shall strictly ensure quarantine of persons as ordered in the GO(Rt)No.591/2021/DMD dated 03.09.2021. Monitoring of quarantined persons through neighborhood groups/ward level committees/Rapid Response Teams shall be implemented as per the instructions in this regard from Local Self Government Department. The DDMA's shall collect the following details from the Panchayaths and urban local bodies and report the same on daily basis in the format prepared and published by Local Self Government Department.

- i Total COVID-19 affected persons in home quarantine
- ii Total persons in home quarantine due to contact tracing
- iii Number of containment, micro-containment zones
- iv Number of fines imposed for violation of quarantine norms
- v Persons who are put in mandatory quarantine for violation of quarantine.
- vi. Number of houses where arrangements for supply of medicines and


essential items have been made.
